LOS ANGELES IMMUNIZATION POLICY

While NYFA LA does not require any proof of immunizations, the safety and well being of our community is paramount. We highly recommend students to be up-to-date with recommended vaccinations.

We strongly recommend students to be vaccinated against:

- 1. COVID-19
- 2. Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- 3. Meningococcal (Meningitis)
- 4. Tuberculosis Screening
- 5. Varicella (Chickenpox)
- 6. Polio
- 7. Hepatitis A
- 8. Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis
- 9. HPV (Gardasil)

REQUIREMENTS IN RESPONSE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

In the event of a public health emergency, NYFA may require additional immunizations to protect the health and safety of the NYFA community. Any additional immunizations required of students will be fully described in the NYFA Public Health Emergency Immunization Policy, published and distributed, as needed.

WHERE TO GO TO GET IMMUNIZED
