TRANSFER OF CREDIT FOR MILITARY SERVICE

The New York Film Academy (NYFA) offers credit for military service. To request an evaluation of military service, submit a copy of the Joint Services Transcript (JST) or Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) transcript to the Academic Affairs Office (LA Campus) and the Registrar's Office (NY Campus and Miami Campus) when you apply to NYFA.

Military Transfer Credits, if accepted by NYFA, would be included in the maximum of 30 semester hours of credits allowable. Credit may also be awarded to veterans of military service who have successfully completed coursework at U.S. military service schools.

Documents are evaluated by the Academic Affairs Office (LA Campus) and the Registrar's Office (NY Campus and Miami Campus) according to recommendations from the American Council on Education (A.C.E.) in accordance with NYFA quidelines. This credit is counted as non-residency transfer work.

Credit may also be awarded to veterans of military service who have successfully completed coursework at U.S. military service schools.
